

2210 — Internet (INET)

Involves the technical planning, design, development, testing, implementation, and management of Internet, intranet, and extranet activities, including systems/applications development and technical management of Web sites. This specialty only includes positions that require the application of technical knowledge of Internet systems, services, and technologies. In most cases, the term Internet is used in the standard to refer generically to Internet, intranet, and extranet systems and services. Functions commonly performed by employees in this specialty may include: determining overall technical design and structure of Internet services; monitoring functionality, security, and integrity of Internet services; troubleshooting and resolving technical problems with the design and delivery of Internet services; collecting and analyzing Internet services usage and performance statistics; evaluating new Internet services and technologies; providing technical advice to Internet content providers; and/or ensuring the rigorous application of information security/information assurance policies, principles, and practices in the delivery of Internet services.
