

**Intelligence Sergeant**  
**Skill Level 2 (SGT)**

The Intelligence Sergeant supervises, performs, and coordinates, collection management, analysis, processing, and dissemination of all-source intelligence products. The Skill Level Two NCO performs duties similar to Skill Level One, in addition provides training and mentorship to subordinate Soldiers. Additionally the Intelligence Analyst analyzes current intelligence holdings to identify gaps, and subsequent intelligence collection requirements; considers enemy Order of Battle records in the development of collection tasks and assessment of enemy vulnerabilities and probable courses of action; assists in the preparation and drafting of periodic and special intelligence reports, Operation Orders (OPORD), Annexes, plans and briefings.

The focus during this phase of a 35F's career should be in developing Soldier and leadership skills, honing technical expertise, and improving the foundation of tactical knowledge and skills. Assignment to a tactical intelligence section within assists in the development of expertise and knowledge to develop a successful NCO. NCOs should seek positions allowing the opportunity of gaining leadership experience, as well as seeking additional duties and attendance to Additional Skill Identifier (ASI) or Special Qualification Identifier (SQI) producing schools.
