

Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance (ISR) Synchronization Manager
Skill Level 2 (SGT)

The ISR Synchronization Manager is responsible for the management of the ISR synchronization process and supporting the tasking, processing, exploitation, and dissemination (TPED) process and associated activities supporting the commander's collection strategy and subsequent ISR activities. Also responsible for support planning and operations during analytical wargaming and the Military Decision Making Process (MDMP) for ongoing and adhoc ISR support and to coordinate and collaborate with operations and other staff elements to develop and revise the ISR plan during every step of the MDMP. The ISR Synchronization Manager's duties include the synchronization of intelligence support to operations and to ISR integration through close coordination with the commander and Staff. Managing intelligence requirements by developing and continuously updating a list of intelligence gaps, analyzing CCIR, PIRs, friendly forces information requirements (FFIR), and IRs to develop generic collection tasks and requests for support from higher and adjacent commands, developing the intelligence synchronization plan, satisfying requirements through intelligence reach, tracking requirements and disseminating intelligence to satisfy CCIR, then PIRs, FFIR, IRs, and other requirements, and evaluating collection reporting and intelligence information.
