

Senior Intelligence Master Analyst
Skill Level 4 (SFC)

An Intelligence Master Analyst (IMA) has the unique responsibility of ensuring that intelligence systems are fully functional and utilized to their fullest extent. The IMA also has the responsibility of ensuring that analysts are capable of performing the intelligence mission. IMA plans, supervises, and instructs unit intelligence sustainment training programs; evaluates unit and individual performance by certifying individual and crew qualifications, conducting sustainment training, assessing operational capability and productivity, preparing SOPs and training documentation, and reporting the appropriate training status to the Commander. An IMA also troubleshoots by isolating and resolving software anomalies and hardware faults; directs the conduct of organizational maintenance of intelligence work station components. Finally the analytical duties of an IMA include planning and supervising intelligence operations to include: IPB, threat situation development, ISR synchronization, and the intelligence communications architecture; by shaping information to support analytical requirements, exploiting system capabilities through process management, directing intelligence analyst activities, orchestrating the intelligence analytical effort, and monitoring intelligence production.
