

Military Intelligence (MI) Senior Leader Course (SLC)

The Senior Leader Course is a module-based, scenario driven course designed to train senior MI NCOs to lead and supervise soldiers, manage intelligence activities and resources as a multi-skilled technician in a maneuver support role. Students are trained and evaluated in their ability to analyze and solve multiple problem sets at any command echelon using the Military Decision Making Process, Intelligence Preparation of the Battlefield, Critical Thinking, Collection Management, Strategic Intelligence and Cultural Awareness. Additionally, all Senior NCOs are required to research, write, and brief a formal paper incorporating the MDMP, the Intel Cycle, ISR Architecture and an Intelligence Electronic Warfare (IEW) system, and the application of Strategic Intelligence and Culture Awareness. Other subjects of instruction include Terrorism in the 21st Century, Denial and Deception, and Ethical Reasoning. Students use analysis tools such as Pathfinder, ArcGIS, Analyst Notebook and Biometric Automated Toolset (BAT). The course culminates with a Situational Training Exercise (STX). During the STX students perform in various leadership and supervisory roles, applying and validating what they learned throughout the course.
