

**Army Basic Instructor Course (ABIC)**  
**SQI: 8**

The Army Basic Instructor Course (ABIC) is a comprehensive, structured course which trains individuals on how to prepare and present effective training sessions. Students develop and present three complete lesson plans/teaching plans; one using the Lecture/Conference Method of instruction, one using the Socratic Discussion Method of Instruction, and one which integrates Socratic Questioning with a demonstration and practical exercise.

An Instructor/Writer is responsible for training, preparing lesson plans, preparing training support materials and evaluations for Advanced Individual Training (AIT) students, international and or reclassification students to perform their jobs in both garrison and tactical environments. Instructor/Writer provides counseling and mentorship to students to assist towards successful completion of the course, and participates by providing input and feedback in all aspects of training development; too include the completion of Training Requirements Analysis System (TRAS) documentation. While serving in this position the Instructor/Writer will use the knowledge and experience gained from previous assignments, and lessons learned to enforce the training standards for MI MOSs and ensure that field and garrison commanders receive highly trained, fully competent Soldiers ready to accept challenging missions worldwide.
